

- Select the burial date and contact Holy Cross Cemetery office at (216) 641-7575 x 3.
- Discuss burial plans with a Family Service Representative.
- Set an appointment to select a new burial location or to confirm existing burial arrangements.
- Complete the burial contract. The cemetery will need a completed contract and signature in order to authorize a burial.
- Provide the cremation certificate to your Family Service Representative.

- Holy Cross cemetery will need at least 48 hours notice in order to accommodate a burial request. Burials may take place Monday-Saturday 9:00 a.m.-2:30 p.m. (excluding certain holidays).
- Burials that are scheduled late in the afternoon, from 3:00-5:00 p.m. will incur an additional charge.
- If you would like a priest or deacon at the service, each family will arrange this with the church. It is best to have this confirmed with the church before selecting the burial date/time.
- The day before the scheduled burial, your Family Service Representative will contact you to provide your *Gathering Place*. The Gathering Place is the meeting location for family and friends as they arrive to the cemetery. Please share the YouTube video link provided on page 9; this information will be useful to those that will be attending the burial.



- Burial containers- Family Service Representatives will need to confirm the container information when scheduling the burial.
- In ground burials- remains must be in a CCA approved cultured marble urn or be placed inside a cremation burial vault.
- Above ground burials- burial container dimensions should be available in order to ensure the container will fit inside the niche.
- Double niches- will need to consider both burial container sizes.





- A wooden pedestal will be setup at the burial location, The urn or burial container may be placed on the pedestal for the service.
- If you would like to be present for the burial, please discuss this with your Family Service Representative as you are planning the burial and finalizing burial details.

The Day of Burial

- Family and friends should arrive at the cemetery gathering location at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled burial time.
- The escort will collect the cremation certificate before you proceed to the burial location. (Unless the certificate was previously provided when scheduling the burial).
- Cremation Certificates: Please note we will NOT be able to complete a burial if a cremation certificate has not been received.
- Gravesite services are typically 15-20 minutes long.

- Once the service is complete, the family is asked to waive over the field staff so that they may complete the burial.
- Once the staff approaches the burial location, guests may proceed to their vehicles.
- Remains should never be left unattended.
- If you would like to be present for the burial, and did not previously arrange this with the FSR, please waive the field staff to the burial location and let them know that you would like to be present until the burial has been completed.
